Foot & Ankle Surgery Information

- Majority of Surgeries are day surgery
- Borrow equipment from Red Cross Loan Cupboard
- Elective surgery no at home care provided post-op

Surgical Pathway:

- Foot needs time to heal properly putting weight on too early or smoking will compromise healing & surgical outcome
- See Surgeon at roughly 2, 6 and 12 weeks after surgery
- Do not put any weight on surgical foot for first 2 -3 weeks post op at least, minimum of 6 weeks for patients who have fusions in the foot.
- **Either foot** no driving while non-weight bearing
- Leave splint/cast on until first visit with Surgeon usually 2-3 weeks post-op (If KGH did not give you a post op appt in Ambulatory Care, please call the office to book or call Ambulatory care at 250-862-4400)
- Sponge bath first 2-3weeks DO NOT get splint/cast wet
- 2-3-week post-op visit at Ambulatory Care at KGH staples removed
- You will be transitioned into a Robo boot if necessary, at your 2 weeks post op visit. This can be fitted and purchased through the ambulatory care clinic at your follow up visit. Or can be purchased at Three sixty Physio (778) 484-0360.
 - Wear day & night, can take off while seated
- 6 week visit at Ambulatory Care at KGH will gradually begin weight bearing with direction of Surgeon over 4 weeks) 25-50-75 then (100%)
- Robo boot during day, off at night after 6 weeks (on at night before 6 weeks)
- May begin Physiotherapy at 6 weeks
- 12 week visit at Ambulatory Care should be full weight bearing, back to regular activities as directed by Surgeon
- Foot & ankle may be swollen several months, very common and not of concern
- Continued Functional and pain improvements gains will continue over the first 2 years
